Instructions for Maintenance and Care of Toddler Tables

Once the Toddler Table is properly assembled, it is ready for immediate use. Adults should never sit or stand on the Toddler Table. If your Toddler Table is to be moved, it should be lifted by at least two strong adults. It should never be pushed or slid across the floor.

All bolts used to attach the leg brackets to the underside of the Toddler Table and the bolts through the tubular legs should be checked for tightness at least every three months. Bolts should be tight but not over tightened. If used improperly, leg brackets can be torn from their inserts, which have been carefully placed on the underside of the table. Should leg brackets ever become torn from the inserts, discontinue use of the table immediately.

Toddler Table seats can be removed for cleaning by lifting the back of the seat with one hand while pushing up on the bottom of the seat with the other hand. Seats should be pushed into seat holes until they “snap” in to place.

Always use the seat belts that are provided with the Toddler Table. If a seat is not in use, the seat belt should be buckled with the seat belt strap pulled tight. Never leave seat belts hanging loose when the seats are empty.

Toddler Tables and seats should be cleaned as needed using a mild detergent. Never use cleaning chemicals that might be harmful to children.
